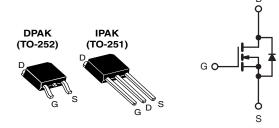

DESCRIPTION

Third generation power MOSFETs from Vishay provide the designer with the best combination of fast switching, ruggedized device design, low on-resistance and cost-effectiveness.

The DPAK is designed for surface mounting using vapor phase, infrared, or wave soldering techniques. The straight lead version (IRFUC, SiHFUC series) is for through-hole mounting applications. Power dissipation levels up to 1.5 W are possible in typical surface mount applications.

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TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS (25 °C, unless otherwise noted)

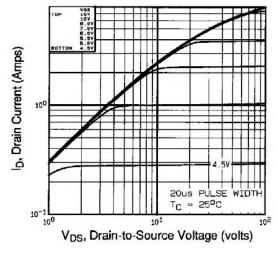


Fig. 1 - Typical Output Characteristics, $T_C = 25 \ ^{\circ}C$

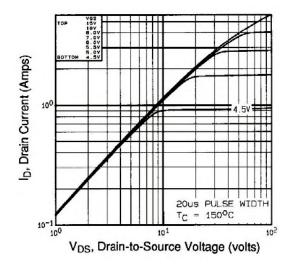


Fig. 2 - Typical Output Characteristics, T_C = 150 °C

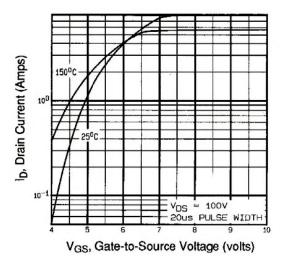


Fig. 3 - Typical Transfer Characteristics

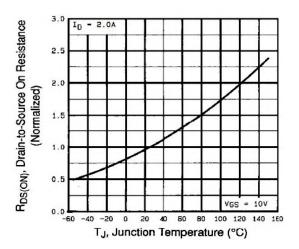
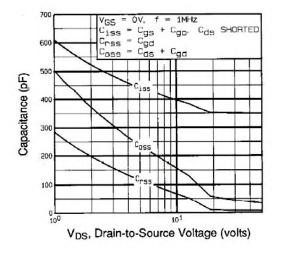
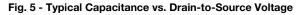


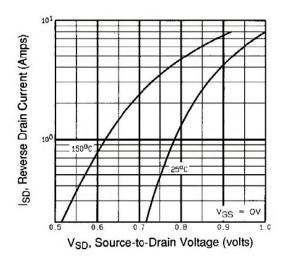
Fig. 4 - Normalized On-Resistance vs. Temperature



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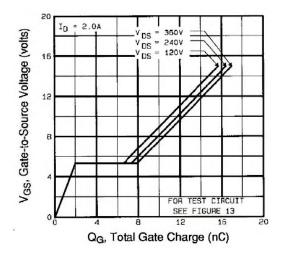


Fig. 6 - Typical Gate Charge vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

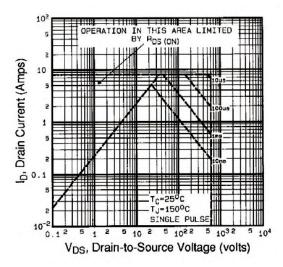


Fig. 8 - Maximum Safe Operating Area

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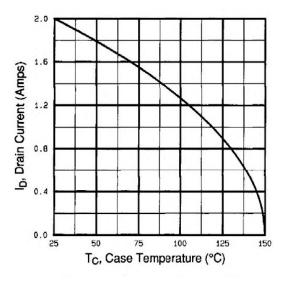


Fig. 9 - Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature

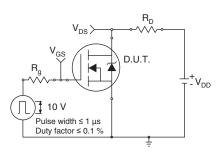


Fig. 10a - Switching Time Test Circuit

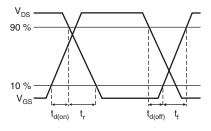


Fig. 10b - Switching Time Waveforms

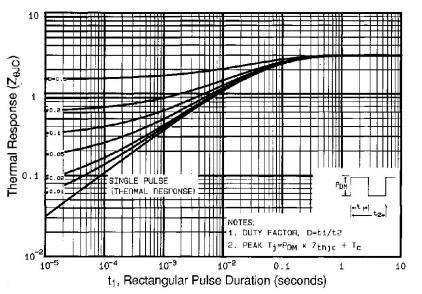


Fig. 11 - Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Case



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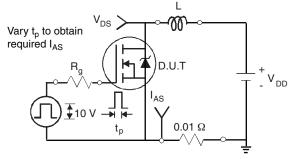


Fig. 12a - Unclamped Inductive Test Circuit

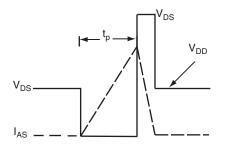


Fig. 12b - Unclamped Inductive Waveforms

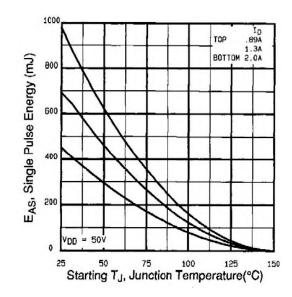


Fig. 12c - Maximum Avalanche Energy vs. Drain Current

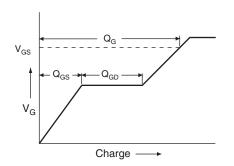


Fig. 13a - Basic Gate Charge Waveform

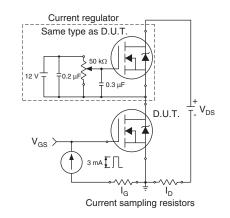
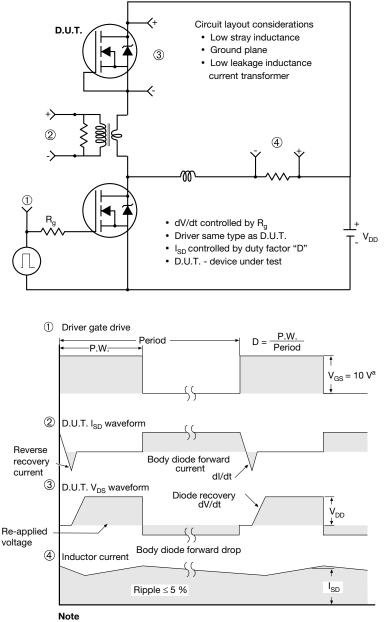


Fig. 13b - Gate Charge Test Circuit

Fig. 14 - For N-Channel

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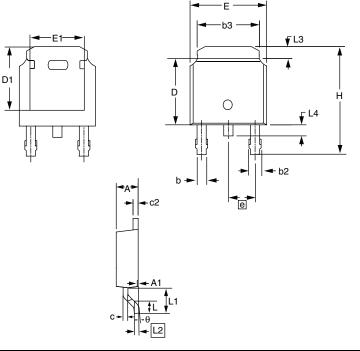

4. Dimension "b" does not include dambar protrusion. Allowable dambar protrusion shall be 0.10 mm total in excess of "b" dimension at maximum material condition. The dambar cannot be located on the lower radius of the foot.
